General Description	<p>The mission is incorporated in a difficult context especially among youths : resignation and discontentment are increasing and could be perceptible with the important non-participation in the last European elections.</p> <p>The project is carried by 3 young people for 8 months in a "Service Civique" context.</p>
Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To reinforce the capacity to act of the young people so that they can build a society in their image with a special attention given to a removed audience or with the "fragile one's". - To talk about Europe by interrogating the common values and what is making sense in youth's daily life. The aim is to cross points of view , to strengthen that those values are still current and shape our community. - To identify potential avenues about European citizenship. They will be the bases for exchanges between young Europeans, people of Nantes, politics and European associations during the workshop.
